



3 P's of Peace Making: Practice

- Give your life to Jesus
- Forgive someone
- Pursue somebody
- Intercede/Pray
- Read a book on an area your heart breaks for
- Pursue a discussion on a topic you are passionate about
- Serve in our city with an FAC Serve Team
- Prayer walk
- Make friends with someone who thinks differently than you
- Pursue counseling on concepts like unforgiveness & bitterness
- Volunteer to support a cause or group in town.
- Talk to your kids about what's going on in the world.
- Study scripture on topics like peace, justice, mercy, and reconciliation.
- Set regular rhythms to self examine your own heart
- Ask questions *and* listen
