Matthew 13, John 4, Matthew 28

Journeys

1. How does Peter’s journey give us hope and perspective on our own?
2. What areas, if you’re willing to share, do you feel are most “unfinished” in your life right now that you need God’s intervention?
3. What about Tim’s journey challenges or encourages you?

Stories

1. What do we learn about Jesus from the story of the Samaritan woman? Who does he *see*, how does he approach relationship, what is his heart for people?
2. Why is it important for our workers to stay in place in difficult locations around the world even though the stories are long and complicated?
3. Who in your life feel “unfinished” but is worth your time, effort and care?

Mission

1. The disciples had their expectations upended regularly by Jesus because he was always calling them deeper, to what really mattered. Where do you see some of your own expectations or desires challenged or needing changed by Jesus?
2. Why is it essential for our workers to be in that 80% of no gospel access?
3. What would it look like to partner financially, in prayer, in sending, in going?
4. What ideas is God stirring that would lead you or your group to partner more intentionally with the international work of the C&MA?
