Asking for a friend: The Conscience: What is it and how does it work in my life?

1. John Calvin stated there are three things God created to restrain evil in the World: The family, government and the conscience. Discuss how these three entities work together and the negative impact if they are not working properly.
2. What is the conscience in a person's life and how does it work in cooperation with the Holy Spirit and Holy Scripture?
3. Why is teaching about the conscience important in an age of Self-Definition?
4. What is the ultimate motive of the conscience's work in your life? What is ultimate desired outcome for you?
5. What happens to our conscience when we continue to not listen to what it says?
6. Can you give an example of a cultural conscience and how a cultural conscience has changed over time?
7. Can you give examples of theological absolutes, biblical principles, personal convictions and personal preferences in a person's life?
8. What do we do when Christians have two different perspectives on an issue of conscience?
9. How is the Cross of Christ the answer for the person who struggles with a guilty conscience?
10. Give an example of when you followed your conscience on a matter.
