Choose some of the following questions to review with your group and then spend some time in prayer for each other. You could also use the three-question method suggested in the Life Group Leader emailed article from this last week if you would like!

Icebreaker Opening Question:

What is a home project, craft or hobby that you tried that didn't go so well?

Light Applied to Life: Walk in Confidence!
Read together 1 John 5:6-21

1. Have you ever longed for certainty about something? Recall a time where waiting in uncertainty was difficult.
2. Do you think that our world longs for this sort of confidence and certainty that John writes about?
3. Where do you think the desire for moral relativism comes from? How might moral relativism be associated with our passage/topic this week?
4. What does it mean for you to have eternal life “right here and right now?” How should it affect our lives today? How would you explain this to someone?
5. Do you find prayer confusing? (For example, does prayer really change anything? What is our role in prayer?, etc.). Do John’s words about prayer in this passage open up your understanding and confidence in prayer? What does it say?
6. How do you know if you are praying “in the will of God?” What would the hallmarks be of a prayer prayed “in the will of God”?
7. What does it mean to you that you are part of the family of God, his child? And how does this help in our fight against sin?
8. Do you have confidence in your salvation? When did you get that? How did you get that? What does that mean to you?

Pray for each other as a group, perhaps praying Scripture over some of the requests!
