Have you ever run out of gas while traveling in a car? If so what was the occasion and how did you handle it?

**Finding Hope for the Empty  
Read together Ecclesiastes 2: 1-11**

1. In our lives that can be very full, how is it that we can feel so empty?
2. Can you remember a time when you felt spiritually empty? What was it like, how did it affect you and how did you come out of it?
3. In reading Ecclesiastes 2: 1-11, list how many different things Solomon pursues in his quest for meaning and sustained happiness.
4. Why would God allow us for a season to pursue fulfillment in things other than himself, and what lesson would God be wanting to teach us?
5. What role does the Word of God play in feeding our spiritual hunger?
6. Our Heavenly Father will pour out his blessings in our lives, but often we can make the blessings more important than the One who blesses. How can we keep this from happening, and why is it so important to keep our hearts ordered with proper affection?
7. Solomon asked the Lord for wisdom to govern, and his father David asked the Lord for a greater knowledge of his Lord (Ps 27: 4-5). What is the difference in these requests and how can we follow David's pattern?
