As a reminder, choose the best questions for your group. You can design your own, have your group bring their questions, or use the ones below as a helpful guide. The point of reviewing the message and group discussion is growing deeper in your application of the sermon, not just discussing answers.

Intro Question Options:

- October means Major League Baseball! Will anyone in your small group watch this year's world series on TV?

Read Ephesians 4: 1-4, then choose a few of the following questions to discuss.

- Looking back, are there people you feel God providentially brought into your life at crucial times? Who? How did God use them? (If this is a couples' group, ask if anyone has seen God providentially bring someone into one of their children's lives is also a great thing to celebrate!)
- Looking back, is there a time when you feel God brought someone across your path that could have helped you, but you resisted the relationship?
- Are there those in your circle of relationships that would say YOU are someone God providentially dropped into their lives?
- Have two or three people read the following from two or three different translations: Proverbs 13:20
 - What is the promise to those who "walk" with the wise?
 - What is the consequence of being a companion of fools?
- Have two or three people read the following from two or three different translations: Ecc. 4: 8-9
 - Why is walking with someone through life better than alone?
 - Why do we sometimes choose to walk alone?

Closing questions:

What is your main take away from the message? What impacted you most?
What is one relational next step you can take as a person?
