Intro Question Options:

- Did you watch football yesterday? If so did your team win? Did you watch a hallmark movie over the Thanksgiving weekend? If so, did you figure out the ending before the movie ended? ☺

Choose a few of the following questions to discuss.

- What are one or two things you learned about the song of Mary today?
- What are the three things that Pastor Paul mentioned that make Mary special as a Biblical figure? Can you think of any other?
- How is what happened to Mary in a physical specific sense transferable to us as Christians in general spiritual sense?
- What are characteristics of a woman who is pregnant, and what can we learn from this as we who possess the Holy Spirit?
- Mary stated that, "He has performed mighty deeds with his arms." (Vs 51) How does this point to the work of Jesus on the cross and what does this communicate about our true spiritual need as people?
- Mary responds to the Angel, "I am the Lords servant." (vs. 37) For Mary to be a servant in the plan of redemption, what cost would it mean for her socially? Why is this significant, and what can we learn from this?
- Why did God choose Mary? Was there something about Mary or does this communicate something about God?
