Intro Question Options:

- What is one item/thing that you experienced in your childhood that children today do not experience? What is one item/thing today that children experience that you wish you would have experienced?

Read Romans 1: 16-17, 3: 19-26

Choose a few of the following questions to discuss:

- If someone would ask you to define the Gospel of Jesus Christ, what would you tell them? Is it one thing of many things?
- Why is the Jewish/Gentile conflict in the church at Rome so significant in reading correctly the book of Romans?
- In Romans how does theology serve relationships and the church's mission?
- When you imagine that of a "living sacrifice" what comes to mind? How do you think Paul meant this to be played out in a Christian's life?
- What is the power of a transformed community by the Gospel, and why is it so important to the mission of the Church in the world?
- Before telling of the glory of the gospel (3: 19-26), why does Paul start with the tragedy of the human condition in chapters 1 through 3?
- If righteousness is not obtained through the law, they how can righteousness in God's sight be obtained? By faith in what? And why is this important?

Closing question:

What is your main take away from the message? What is the application of that?
