Intro Question Options:

- Do you have any special plans for Easter Sunday? Do you have any traditions around this time that you enjoy?

Read Romans 3: 19-26, 4: 1-12, 5: 1-11

Choose a few of the following questions to discuss:

- How do most Christians define "the gospel"? How do you define it? If the gospel is indeed "the power of God," how should that power be demonstrated among those who have embraced the Christian gospel? In what ways is the power of God evident in the church? Romans 1: 16-17
- What does this chapter say about the spiritual condition of the Jews in Chapter 2? What might be similar spiritual condition of a person in Central Kentucky?
- Paul says in Chapter 3 "all have sinned". Why do you think he spent so much time establishing that? What impact does this have on how we view others around us (believers and nonbelievers)?
- Why is the truth of *justification* found in Chapter 3 so important to the Christian faith and how is it distinctive from other world religions?
- In Chapter 4 Paul says that Abraham, "believed God," and he was the Father of the faithful. What does it mean to you to "believe God"? What personal illustrations can you offer from your own life in trusting God? How is your life different because you believe in God compared to those who do not?
- In chapter 5 Paul says that because of Jesus, "we have peace with God." As a group think of all the ways the work of Christ has brought peace to our lives.
- Why is Romans chapters 1-5 so important to local and global missions?

Closing question:

What is your main take away from the message? What is the application of that?
