Ice breaker:

What is your favorite Maundy Thursday, Good Friday or Easter tradition?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Choose a few of the following questions to discuss:

- Paul says that the Resurrection of Jesus Christ is of "first importance" and yet we often hear sermons on the resurrection just once a year. Why do you think that is?
- In Acts 9, Saul, who would become Paul, meets the risen Lord and he acknowledged him as Lord. Why is it so important that we acknowledge the risen Jesus as Lord and how are practical ways we could do it?
- Because Christ has been raised it assures us that we who are "in Christ" will receive a new glorified body. How much thought do you give to the promise of a glorified body and does it practically affect your daily life?
- Christ's resurrection means the renewal of all creation. When you think of this truth what does your imagination do? How do you see the New Heaven and the New Earth? How does that change anything in your present earthly life?
- The book of Ephesians says we are "raised with Christ" and "seated with Christ". How do these truths affect issues of identity and personal value?
- Jesus stated that he would be crucified and then on the third day he would rise from the dead. Why is it so important that Jesus stated he would rise from the dead? How does that build faith in us in the promises of Jesus?
- In your opinion...what is the most impactful aspect of the resurrection? How has that changed your life?

Closing question:

What is your main take away from the message? What is the application of that?
