## Sunday Sermon – April 23, 2023

Icebreaker Opening Question: With the arrival of Spring and the warm weather, yard work becomes a necessity. Do you enjoy yard work? Do you have a garden? Flowers? Do you consider a joy to welcome in spring, or are you more of a fall/winter person?

## Romans – In the Grip of Grace- Read Romans 9: 1-5, 10: 1-21

- 1. What is Paul saying in 9:3? His heart is broken for the lost of Israel. What does that say about our hearts needing to be broken for lost people?
- 2. The Jewish people were very religious and yet Paul said they were spiritually lost, How could this be? Please read 10: 14. How would you get the subject of God's grace in a conversation with someone who was religious and didn't see their need for grace?
- 3. How would you define 'God's sovereignty"? Can you give a scriptural <u>and</u> personal example?
- **4**. How do you reconcile the tension between man's responsibility and God's sovereignty in the a events of our world?
- 5. God stated, 'I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy and compassion on who I have compassion.' How does the character of God help us see these actions of God as good and holy?
- 6. Paul said that God chose to bless the Gentiles in order to bring the Jewish people saving faith. How does this connect with the need to live a life pleasing to God for the sake of allowing others to see a life in harmony with God's plan?
- 7. Is there a time you have deeply wrestled with (or are currently wrestling with) God's sovereignty in a situation personal to you? Please share it with the group.
- 8. What are some practical ways that we can love people as they wrestle through the ideas and Scriptures from this week?

Pray for each other as a group, especially in areas brought up as hard as we wrestle through this passage. End by reading encouraging Scripture as a benediction for your time.
