5. How can we have such confidence in our hope and the security it brings? What are the two things God stated about himself and what does 1 Peter 1:3 say?
6. How is the resurrection of Jesus Christ connected to our hope and why is it so important?
7. How does hope spring forth to love in a person's life?
8. What are the three things we can do to grow our hope?
