- ❖ Feel free to make your own questions, have members bring questions, or simply have discussion around the theme of what impacted each member the most, what questions they have, and how you can pray for each other.

Icebreaker opening questions:

If you have been baptized, share with your group what the day was like.

- How old were you?
- Were you in a church, a swimming pool, or a river?
- What details do you remember?

Why Believer's Baptism? Read Romans 6: 1-6

- 1. What are some are some of the reasons that people give to delay their baptism or choose not to get baptized?
- 2. Read Ephesians 2: 1-2. Why is baptism NOT essential for salvation?
- 3. What do people absolutely need to know and believe before being baptized?
- 4. Romans 6:1-6 says we are buried with Christ and raised with Chris. What does this mean and what is the significance of this?
- 5. Why did Jesus say, "Baptize them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit"? What is the significance of this?
- 6. Why should a person get baptized soon after conversion? What significant discipleship principle does this teach?
- 7. Why should baptism be public?
- 8. After today's message and small group discussion have your beliefs on baptism been reaffirmed, clarified, challenged or established?

Spend some time in prayer. Be sure to have a plan in place for communication if someone has a pressing need for prayer arise before the next time you meet.
