“And no one puts new wine into old wineskins; or else the new wine will burst the wineskins and be spilled, and the wineskins will be ruined. But new wine must be put into new wineskins, and both are preserved. And no one, having drunk old wine, immediately desires new; for he says, 'The old is good enough.'”

Luke 5:37-39

Jesus distinguishes here between something essential and primary (the wine) and something secondary but also necessary and useful (the wineskins).. Wineskins include traditions, structures, and patterns of doing things, both collectively and personally which have grown up around the gospel.
