


Assuming a Posture of Prayer




"You can do more than pray after you have prayed. But you can't do more than pray, until you have prayed." —S.D. Gordon

(Nehemiah 1:6)


Reminding God of His Promises

"Give your servant success today by granting favor in the presence of this man [the king]" (Nehemiah 1:11).


