

FAC Life Group Questions
Sunday Sermon – February 18, 2023

Feel free to make your own questions, have members bring questions, or simply have discussion around the theme of what impacted each member the most, what questions they have, and how you can pray for each other.

Icebreaker opening question:

Insecurities: What do you think are the most common among your age group and why?

“Jesus knew who He was-do we?” – Matthew 3: 16-17, 4: 1-11

1. What is the importance of the Holy Spirit descending on Jesus? (See Isaiah 61:1-3 if you need help; it serves to confirm who he is AND to empower his mission).
2. Why did the Father speak these words over His son (see verse 17)? What would the value of this statement be for Jesus as he launched out on his mission? At a human level, what does it do for us when we deeply know and believe the Father's love and approval for us?
3. What does it imply that the Holy Spirit led Jesus into the wilderness for the purpose of being tempted/tested? How could the same event be both a temptation from Satan and a test from God?
4. What common phrase shows up in each of the first two temptations (v. 3 and 6)?
5. What roles do solitude, surrender and the Holy Spirit play in your daily walk with God? Which one do you believe Jesus is asking you to grow in?

Spend some time in prayer. Be sure to have a plan in place for communication if someone has a pressing need for prayer arise before the next time you meet.
