Sunday Sermon – February 25, 2023

Feel free to make your own questions, have members bring questions, or simply have discussion around the theme of what impacted each member the most, what questions they have, and how you can pray for each other.

Icebreaker opening question:

Who gave you your first Bible? Who have you given a Bible to and why?

“Jesus trusted God’s Word in _____ times, do we?” – Matthew 3: 16-17, 4: 1-11

1. What do we learn about the Devil and his tactics of temptation from this passage?
2. Is temptation sin? If not, when does sin become sin? (Look to James 1)
3. How does Jesus use the Bible generally or specifically in the face of temptation? What can we learn from this?
4. What are other examples of Jesus’ reliance on the Scriptures in everyday life? Thumb through Matthew’s gospel and find examples of Jesus quoting scripture, Why is scripture so important to Jesus? What does this teach us?
5. Before Adam and Eve were the trees of life and good and evil. How does the garden and the choices for them connect with our choices in life? (Think Moses: “I have set before you life-choose life”. Deut. 30:19)
6. How has your relationship with the Bible changed throughout the years? Have you ever experienced times of Bible dryness? How did you get out of it?

Spend some time in prayer. Be sure to have a plan in place for communication if someone has a pressing need for prayer arise before the next time you meet.
