The issue was identity.

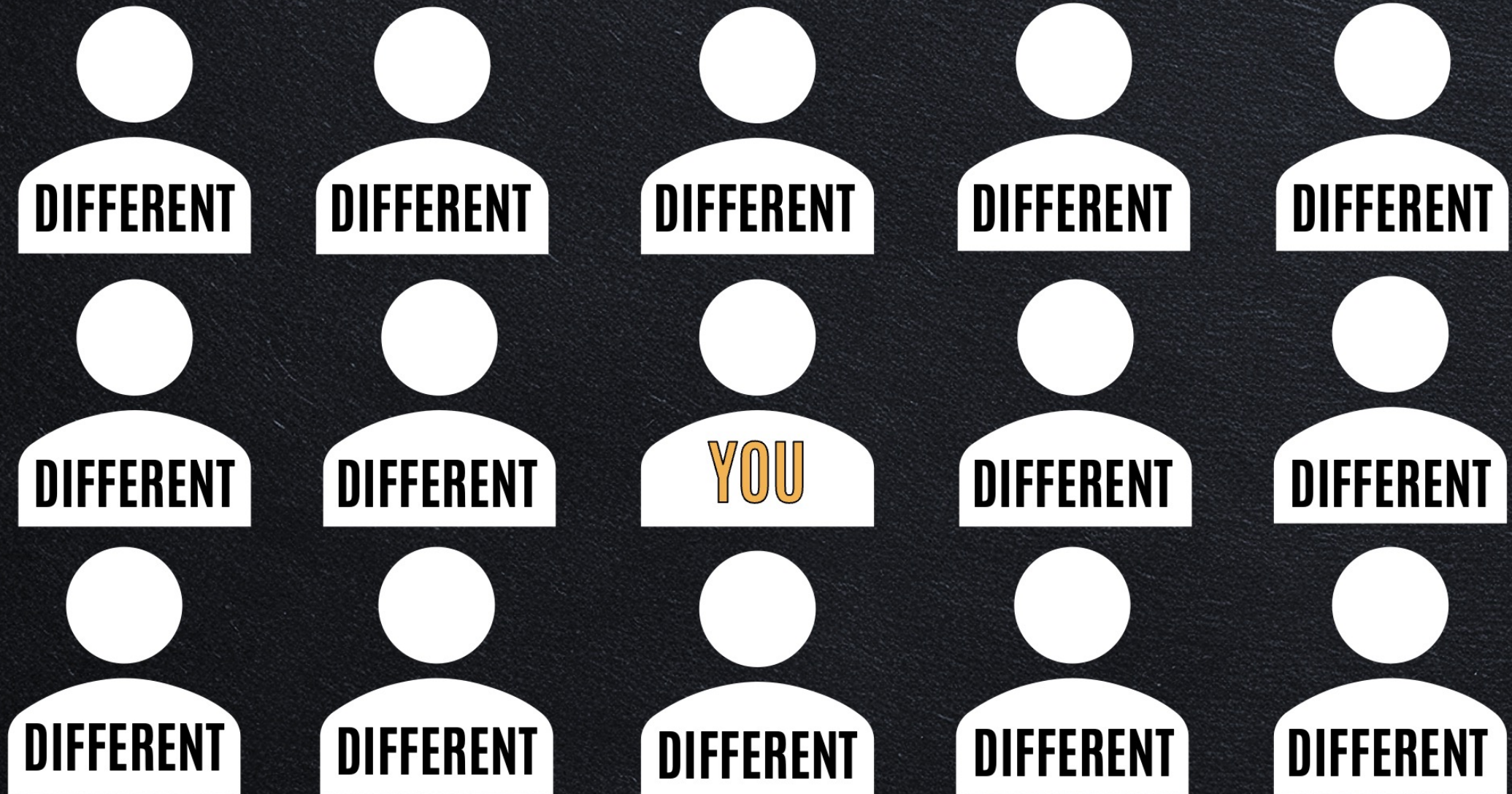
